Pre-Test and Post-Test Information:

The Post-Test is a parallel form of the Pre-Test. Both tests assess the students' vocabulary recognition and oral ability. The first part is multiple choice with vocabulary words and phrases. The second part tests oral proficiency.

Approximate Time: 3 hours

Prerequisite Skills: Students must be able to read and write simple sentences in English and be able to follow simple directions. Students must know cardinal and ordinal numbers. Students need a general understanding of the concept of democracy and the idea of elected representatives. The lesson "Name the Current President" should be taught before this lesson.
