The "I Am" poem is an 18-line, 3 stanza poem. Students usually write an "I Am" poem about themselves, however, in Mrs. Thompson's class we will be using it a different way. Quite often, after reading a story or novel, Mrs. Thompson will ask you to write an "I Am" poem as though you were a character from the story. You will be writing it from his/her viewpoint. Use the following template to do so.
