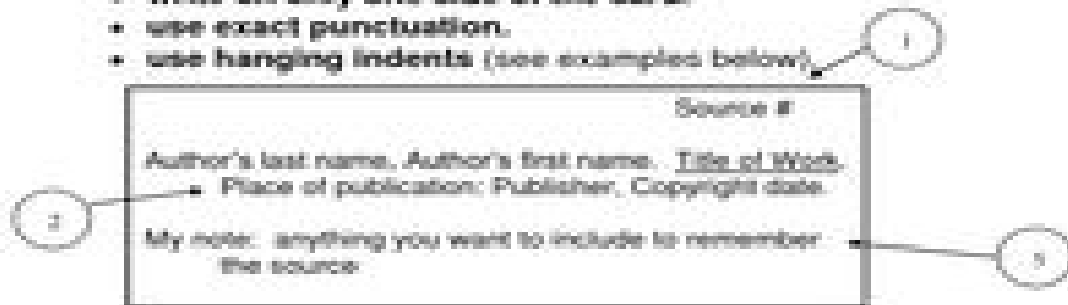


Source Cards (Bibliography Cards)

In preparing source cards, MLA style

- use one index card per source.
- write on only one side of the card.
- use exact punctuation.
- use hanging indents (see examples below).



1. Write the source number on the top right corner to make later relocation easier.
2. Use **hanging indents** (the reverse of regular paragraph indentation) to make the author's last name more visible.
3. **My notes:** Make notes about the book in order to recall it later.
