Microscope Mania Lab

Directions: Use your microscope mania prelab worksheets to help you complete this lab. Each member of a microscope team is responsible for preparing a lab write up and perform the prepared slide and microscope observation skills test. Behave, clean up after yourself, work only with your lab partner, use the equipment properly.

Students will

- 1. dive into the fundamentals of operating a microscope.
- 2. improve skills in preparing slides
- 3. hone observation skills
- 4. get approval for preparing a newspaper "letter" and successfully observing this "letter" under the microscope
- 5. work together to explain their findings and improve their techniques.

Preparing A Microscope Slide

A. <u>WET MOUNT SLIDE</u> – requires a slide, a drop of water, the specimen or object to be observed, and a cover slip. It is important to use water to submerge the living samples (mobile or not). Sometimes a drop of proto-slow is added if viewing fast moving protozoa.

Prepare and observe the letter "e" slide under the microscope. Use the newspaper to locate a small case letter 'e.' Cut out the letter 'e' using scissors. Follow the steps #1-20 to prepare a wet mount slide of the letter 'e.'

- 1. Be sure that the slide is clean—use lens paper to clean it and keep fingerprints off the glass
- 2. Place the slide on a flat, clean surface.
