

PASSIVE VERBS

(Remember: *subject + auxiliary + verb + verb + object*)

| Form | Structure | Example |
|--|---|--|
| Present Simple | Subject + auxiliary + verb + object | Family is always well-behaved. |
| Past Simple | Subject + was + verb + object | My family moved to New York. |
| Present Continuous | Subject + auxiliary + verb + object | The office isn't on the airport anymore! |
| Present Perfect (going to) | Subject + auxiliary + going to be + verb + object | She's going to get three English books. |
| Present Continuous (continuous) | Subject + auxiliary + being + verb + object | He's being strange, isn't he? |
| Past Continuous (continuous) | Subject + auxiliary + being + verb + object | She's always being smart when you're there. |
| Present Perfect (continuous) | Subject + auxiliary + being + verb + object "continuous" continuous "continuous" + going to be | She's never being smart when you're there. |
| Present Perfect | Subject + auxiliary + been + verb + object | She's been here sometimes since the week. |
| Past Perfect | Subject + had + been + verb + object | The book has already been read before that time last year. |
| Present Perfect | Subject + auxiliary + been + verb + object "continuous" continuous "continuous" + going to be | The book has already been read before that time last year. |
| Present Perfect (continuous) | Subject + auxiliary + been + being + verb + object | The book has already been read before that time last year. |
| Past Perfect (continuous) | Subject + had + been + being + verb + object | The book has already been read before that time last year. |
| Present Perfect (continuous) | Subject + auxiliary + been + being + verb + object "continuous" continuous "continuous" + going to be | The book has already been read before that time last year. |
