The Road to Revolution The French and Indian War

 9. In 1763 an Ottawa chief named Pontiac attacked the British fort of Fort Mifflin. Delawares, Shawnees and Senecas captured other British outposts in the Ohio Valley. Other Indians attacked back settlements in Pennsylvania, Maryland and Virginia.
 10. England couldn't afford a continued war with the Indians. The English people were tired of the heavy taxes from all of the other wars. The English government issued a Proclamation in 1763 that set the Ohio Valley aside as an Indian reservation. Settlers were not to cross a line along the crest
