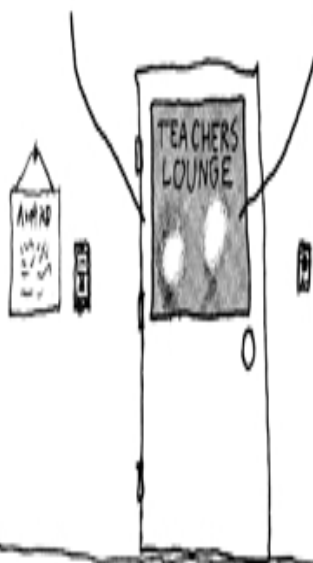


MY STUDENTS DREW ME INTO
