- 8. What did you like best about your practicum experience? What did you enjoy least?
- 9. Describe your overall strengths.
- 10. Describe your overall weaknesses.
- 11. What do you see as some of the current trends in social work?
- 12. Can you give me some examples of how you've been creative in your work?
- 13. What is the most frustrating experience you have had as a social worker and how did you handle it?
- 14. What would be your ideal job?
- 15. Tell me about a time when you made a positive impact on someone.
- 16. What type of clients do you relate to the best? The least?
- 17. How do you keep up with new developments in the field of social work?
- 18. As you look back on your life, what accomplishment do you take the most pride in?
- 19. How do you evaluate a client's progress?
- 20. If I were to ask your clients/supervisors to describe you, what kinds of things would they tell me?
- 21. What required activity related to your job do you regard as the biggest time waster? How would you change it if you could?
- 22. Describe a situation in which you had to work with a client you did not like. How did you handle it?
- 23. Can you tell me what is unique about the strengths perspective and how you have used it with clients?
- 24. Describe a major problem at work you have faced. Tell me your method of dealing with it.
