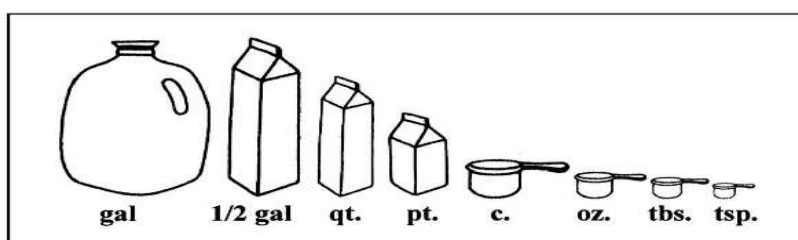


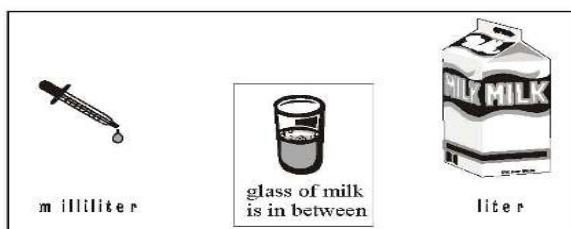
Volume

is the amount of cubic units it takes to fill an object. There are two common systems of measurement:

The **Customary System** is found commonly in the United States. The units of measure in this system are: **teaspoons, tablespoons, ounces, cups, pints, quarts, and gallons.**



The **Metric System** is becoming more common in the United States. The units of measure in this system are: **milliliters and liters.**



*A dropper holds about a milliliter of liquid.
A quart is approximately a liter of liquid.*

$$1000 \text{ milliliters} = 1 \text{ liter}$$
