Teacher Instruction Sheet

First worksheet – Name the Hazards

1. Refer to the **Name the Hazards** PowerPoint. Each slide has pictures of different items related to agriculture that could be hazardous. This PowerPoint can either be used as a slide show and students can complete the worksheet from it or the slides can be printed off. If printing, print off each picture on a separate piece of 8 1/2 x 11 paper. If you choose to use a slide show, give each student a worksheet and go through the slide show, giving students the opportunity to look at each slide and write down potential hazards associated with each. If pictures are printed off, continue below.
2. Have the pictures laminated so they can be used again
3. Set the pictures up as stations around the classroom giving the students room to move around the classroom from one picture (station) to the next.
4. On the worksheet, have the students list potential hazards that each of the pictures could possibly cause or have while using it.
5. Once students have visited each station, discuss the answers they wrote down as a class.

Second Worksheet – Chemical Look A Likes

1. Collect 8 clear containers with lids such as baby food jars or craft containers.
2. Gather a small amount of each of the following products to go inside the containers
 - a. Pancake syrup
 - b. Apple juice
 - c. Mouthwash
 - d. Laundry powder
 - e. Green Sports Drink
 - f. Cooking Oil
