

Teacher's Notes

1 The pictures below are for cutting out, copying or pasting into your notebook to be used as:

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2 Distribute the word cards and word descriptions to the class. Ask students to fold the sheets down the middle. Place the sheet in their notebook. Have each pair of students select a word at the bottom from the words list. Exchange the card - the first will fold the message halfway on the side of the sheet and the other pair will fold the message on the other side of the sheet. Repeat on the other side of the sheet. Now the students exchange the messages with their partners and complete the exercise.

3 Check progress on the word card exercise as a class or in pairs.

4 Practice: Update Words

- Have the students write a new word in their notebook on their partner's card.
- Make additional word cards as necessary.
- Encourage students to present their word cards to their partners.
- Randomize words and mix with other words.
- Have the students add to their notebook as you assign words to pairs.
- Study common observations with a word card found above for additional words.
