Dan likes the sandwiches he can buy at school.  
A ham and salad sandwich costs \$3.50 and a bottle  
of juice cost \$1.20.  
If he buys this everyday for one week, how much  
will he spend?

If Trent puts \$3.00 in his piggy bank each week.  
How much will he have in 12 weeks?  
How much will he have in 1 year?  
How much will he have in 2 years?



If a radio station plays a song every 15 minutes how many songs  
does it play in a day?

If the radio station decides to play 15 songs per hour (from 5:00 p.m.  
to 7:00 p.m.)  
How many songs will they now play in a day?

Dee, Peter and Sarah were all finalists in a no-hands custard  
eating contest.

Dee ate 20 bowls.  
Peter ate 12 and a half bowls.  
and Sarah ate 15 and a half bowls.

How many bowls were eaten all together?

It took Dee 1 hour to finish 20 bowls.  
How many minutes did it take for Peter to finish 1 bowl?



200 people attended the movies  
on a Saturday night.  
125 adults paid full price - \$12.00  
23 pensioners paid - \$9.00  
52 children paid - \$6.00
