

CONDUCTOR AND	INSULATOR

A conductor is a material that allows electricity to flow through it. An insulator is a material that electricity cannot flow through.

To determine whether an object is a conductor or insulator, you can build a simple circuit with a battery, light bulb, and three piece of wire.



Touch the free ends of the wire to the object you are testing. If the light bulb lights up, the object is made from a conductor. If it doesn't, the object is made from an insulator.
