

## Common Questions with How

**How**'s used in a number of various combinations to ask questions. Here are the most common combinations followed by a quiz to test your knowledge.

### How often

**How often**'s used to ask about the frequency with which someone does something.

**Example:** *How often do they go to the cinema?*

### How long does it take?

**How long**'s used to ask about the duration of an activity.

**Example:** *How long does it take to get to Chicago by plane?*

### How various adjectives

**How**'s combined with various adjectives to ask detailed information about an object.

**Example:** *How deep is the ocean? How wide is the playground?*

### How much

**How much**'s used to ask about a singular, non-countable quantity. The most common question is: *How much does it cost?*

**Example:** *How much water is in the bucket?*

### How many

**How many**'s used to ask about plural, countable objects.

**Example:** *How many apples are there in the fridge?*

### How about 'ing'

**How about 'ing'**'s used to make a suggestion.

**Example:** *How about having dinner with me tonight?*

### How do you work

**How do you work**'s used to ask about the manner in which something is done.
