

An action verb tells what a person or thing does.

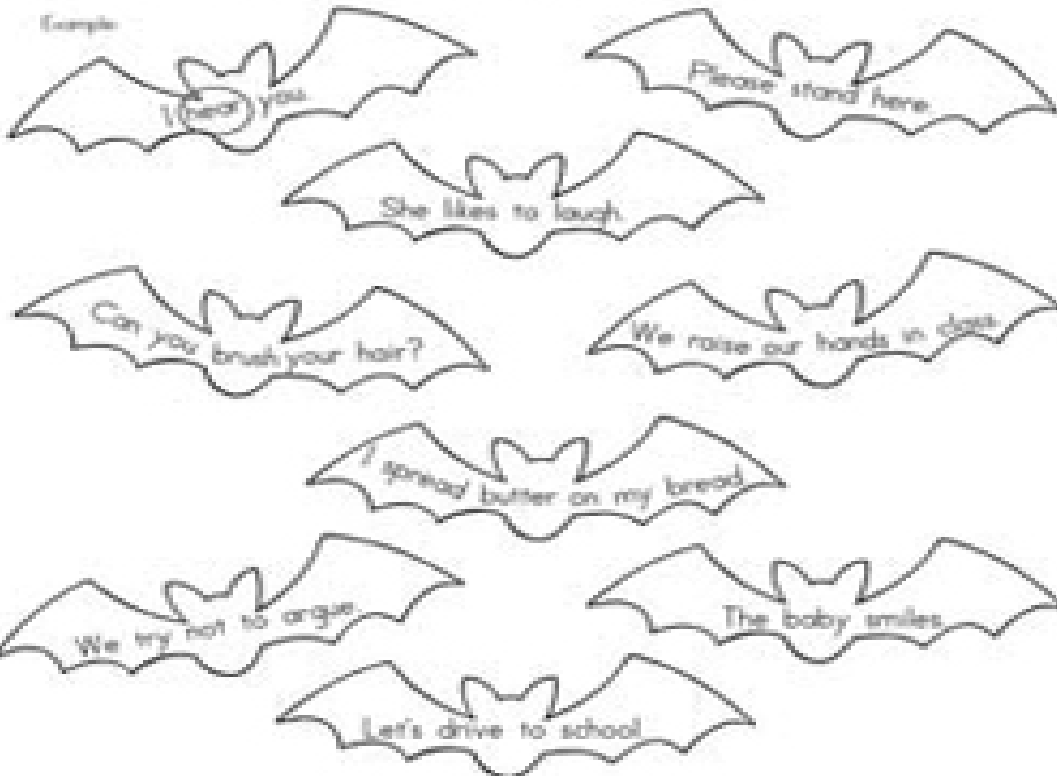


Batty About Verbs
