| 4. <u> C </u> surge protector | D. a drive that is connected to a computer and on which a CD-ROM can be played. |
| 5. <u> H </u> floppy disk drive | E. a display device; the part of the computer that allows you to view what you are doing. |
| 6. <u> B </u> mouse | F. a rectangular box that is the main part of the computer; it contains the drives, the CPU, and the connections for all the cables. |
| 7. <u> D </u> CD-ROM drive | G. an input device; the part of the computer system with letters and numbers for typing. |
| 8. <u> E </u> monitor | H. a drive that writes data onto or retrieves information from 3.5 inch diskettes. |
