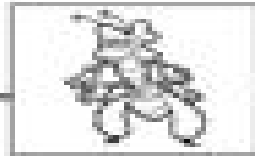
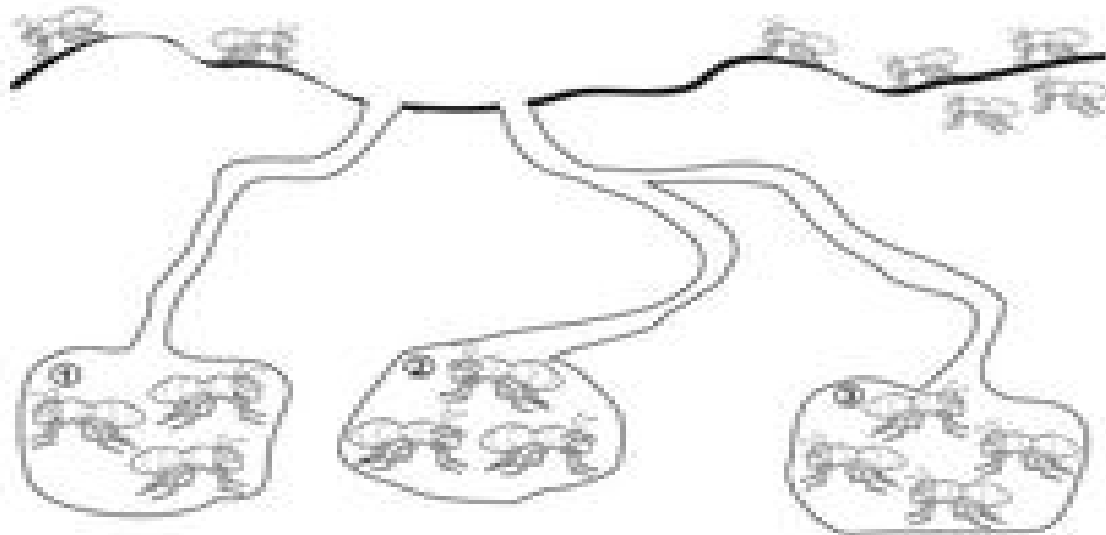


Ant Antics!
