1. Alliteration- the repeating of the same beginning sound in more than two words.

Example: <u>D</u>avid's <u>d</u>og <u>d</u>ug a <u>d</u>itch.

2. **Onomatopoeia**- words that sound like the object or actions they refer to.

Example: The duck went <u>quack!</u>

3. **Personification**- when something not human is given human qualities.

Example: The book winked at me.

4. **Rhyme**- words that have the same end sounds.

Example: <u>D</u>avid's <u>d</u>og <u>d</u>ug a <u>d</u>itch.

5. **Metaphor**- a comparison between two unlike things.

Example: He is a clown.

6. **Simile**- a comparison between two unlike things using "like" or "as."

Example: She cries like a baby.
