3	Heather and Vicki are on their way to Legoland, which is 477 miles away from San Francisco. On the first day, they traveled 289 miles. How many more miles did they have left to travel?	Part-Part-Whole (part unknown)
4	At Westwood elementary school, there are 557 boys and 463 girls. How many more boys than girls are there at the school?	Compare (difference unknown)
5	David had 372 pieces of bait for catching fish. He used up 189 for catching fish. How many pieces of bait does David have left for his next trip?	Separate (result unknown)
6	Yoko and Raven were drawing pictures of cats at recess. Yoko drew 256 cats and Raven drew 307 cats. How many more pictures did Raven draw?	Compare (difference unknown)
7	Sam and Blake were at a two-day long soccer tournament. They kicked 467 balls that weekend. On the first day, they kicked 278 balls. How many did they kick on the second day?	Part-Part-Whole (part unknown)
