

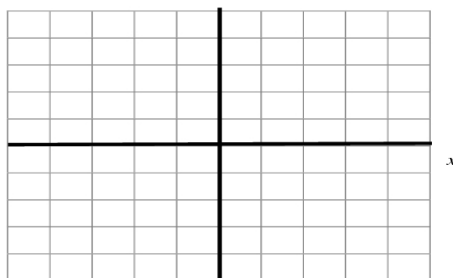

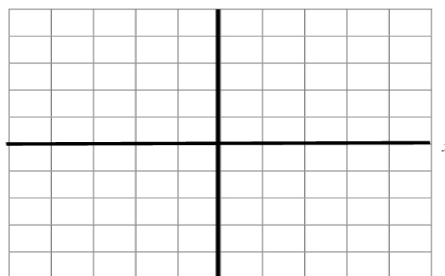
Just like the examples, complete the list of key information, then sketch and label the graph.
