



## THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS

### Future actions exercises

If you want to write or talk about arrangements made for the future you use the **PRESENT CONTINUOUS** tense.

| The PRESENT CONTINUOUS tense |                    |                     |
|------------------------------|--------------------|---------------------|
| VERB: TO DO                  | VERB: TO GO        | VERB: TO SEE        |
| I'm doing                    | I'm going          | I'm seeing          |
| You're doing                 | You're going       | You're seeing       |
| He/she/it is doing           | He/she/it is going | He/she/it is seeing |
| We are doing                 | We are going       | We are seeing       |
| They are doing               | They are going     | They are seeing     |

**Examples:**

- Next week **I'm going** to the theatre.
- When **are you getting** married?
- **He is seeing** his mother on Tuesday
- **She is travelling** to York at the weekend.
