CLUES:

- 1) Bob is sitting in the middle.
- 2) The boys are named Mark, Bob and Matthew.
- 3) Jane is from Canada.
- 4) 1 girl is from Canada, 1 girl is from South Africa.
- 5) The girl next to Bob is wearing boots.
- 6) Mark does not come from Japan.
- 7) Bob is next to the boy from Singapore.
- 8) Matthew is in seat number 5.
- 9) Mark is on Bob's left.
- 10) The boy from Singapore is wearing glasses.
- 11) Bob is not next to Matthew or Jane.
- 12) Mark does not wear a hat or a suit.
- 13) Helena is wearing boots.
- 14) The girl from Canada is not next to the boy from Japan.
- 15) 1 girl is wearing a hat, 1 girl is wearing boots.
- 16) The boys wearing shorts and a suit are not next to each other.
- 17) The boy next to Mark is wearing shorts.
- 18) The boy from Japan is not wearing a suit.
