Third, Presidents have adopted different measures for strengthening radio news transmission. The Soviet Union has adopted systematic steps to expand the production of radio equipment and to professionally train radio players, which helped considerably strengthen their transmission. The Soviet news agencies set up 10 regional stations in all fifteen zones by the end of 1950, whereas previously, four publications from Moscow had been sent to twelve out of fifteen non-Prodromos regions.

Right now, however, we're not doing very much at either those energy levels for any of our customers. A general decline in energy use has been going on for quite some time now. The reason for that is that people have more efficient equipment, they're more energy-aware, they're more energy-conscious. They're more aware of how much energy they're using.
