

Adjective clauses

Adjective clauses - modify a noun

- start the sentence with relative pronouns: who, which, that, etc.
- can not stand alone, but must be connected to main clause

1. **Using subject pronouns: who, which, that**

Example:

The man **who lives next to me** is friendly.

S	V
The man	is
who lives next to me	friendly
S	V

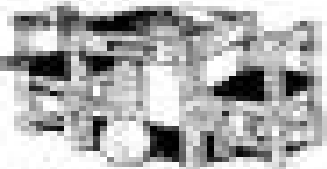


⇒ The man **who lives next to me** is friendly.

The book **which is on the table** belongs to me.

S	V
The book	is
which is on the table	belongs to me
S	V



⇒ The book **which is on the table** belongs to me.
