Common and Proper Nouns

A **common noun** names a general person, place or thing.

example: I went to the park.
the garden bed.

A **proper noun** names a specific person, place, or thing. Always
include the first letter of a proper noun.

example: I went to Washington.
St. Louis was built.
My new paper, news, is fantastic.
