Lab Safety Rule Sheet

A science laboratory can be a safe place to work if you, the student, plan ahead and are alert and cautious. The following practices will be followed.

- 1. Read lab procedures before starting the lab.
- 2. Do not start the lab without your teacher's permission.
- 3. Only teacher is allowed in the storeroom or preparation area.
- 4. Know the locations of the fire extinguisher, eye wash and shower station, and fire alarm box.
- 5. Wear goggles whenever chemicals, glassware or heat is used in the laboratory.
- 6. Do not carry hot equipment or dangerous chemicals.
- 7. Pull back long hair and remove jewelery while in the laboratory.
- 8. Handle chemical bottles with extreme care.
- 9. Keep hands away from the face and wash immediately after the lab activity is over.
- 10. Do not look directly into glassware that is being heated.
- 11. Notify your teacher when you suspect a dangerous lab situation (such as injury, broken glassware, or spilled chemicals.)
- 12. Unplug the electrical plug from its socket by pulling on the plug, not the electrical cord.
- 13. Clean up your work area at the end of each laboratory activity.
- 14. Dispose of all garbage properly.
