Penguin Parents

Emperor penguin parents are truly remarkable! They share the responsibilities of caring for their offspring. The female lays one egg, which she places on the male's feet. He keeps the egg between the top of his feet and a special fold of skin on his tummy. He is careful not to drop the egg. While the female goes back to the sea, the father **huddles** on the ice with other dads for two months. The males do not eat during this time. The female returns when the egg is ready to hatch. She feeds the chick a meal of fish. The male goes to find food in the sea for himself and the chick. Both parents then share the work of feeding the chick.
