

### Consonant digraphs th and sh

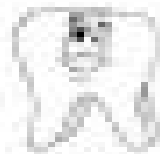
- **Rule:** A consonant digraph is two consonants that are together. They stand for one sound.

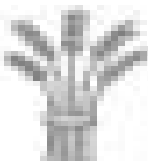
