## 7<sup>th</sup> GRADE COMPUTERS

This exploratory class will place emphasis on reviewing correct keyboarding skills and more challenging word-processor activities such as composing letters, doing column tables, reports with graphics, bulleting activities, designing creative signs. They will have a weekly journal topic with a website to research and illustrate from a paint program and then complete a power point presentations from there journal. They will be able to place spreadsheet graphs in word documents and label all axes including the titles and write a summary. Students will create databases to track their Journal topics, Internet research, explorations assignments, and domains of each website. All students are required to compete part an Education Development Plans (EDP). Students will complete a survey called matchmaker, which suggests the Michigan Career Pathway that bests suits them. Students will select a pathway along with a career that interests them.

- 12 Use CareerCruising.com to complete there EDP's
