A forest is an area with many trees. These forests are home to many animals and plants.

They are located in many areas near the Equator.

A rainforest grows in 4 layers with different trees, flowers and other plants in each layer. Look at the picture.



The climate in the Tropical Rainforest is wet and warm, and it rains almost everyday.

The rainforest doesn't have seasons like we do. Leaves and trees are always green.

More than half of all the species of plants, animals and insects live in the rainforest.
