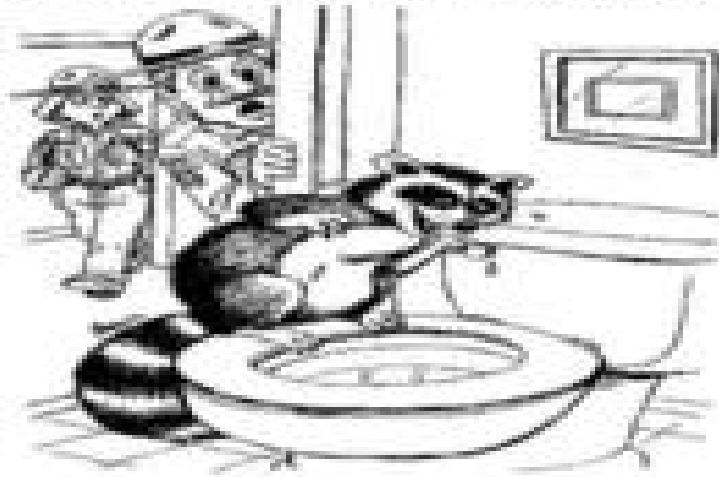


Subject Verb Agreement
