6th Grade World History Country Research Paper Due Dates and Explanations

The sixth graders will be writing a research paper about a country. East student will get a country to write the paper on. This research paper is due on Friday, March 4, 2011, at the end of the third quarter. The grade will go on their $4^{\,\mathrm{th}}$ quarter report card

The following is an itinerary of scheduled due dates for the paper:

- 1) Select country. The students will write the country of their choice on an index card and turn it in on Friday, Oct. 8.
- Class 6A pp. R22-R24 (in the world history textbook) Class 6B pp. R25-R27 (ditto above)
- 2) Written goals What do the students want to learn about their country? This is your topic for now. Due Wednesday, Oct. 20.
- 3) Four sources (minimum) Due Friday, Nov. 5. Bring to class four sources (book, magazine, website, or person). We will color-code or assign numbers to these sources. Read them and study the information about your topic.
- 4) Narrow your topic and write 3 research questions; write 1 thesis statement. Due Friday, Nov. 19.
- 5) Turn in a set of at least 20 note cards with notes pertaining to the chosen topic and thesis statement. One note goes on each of these cards. Write the source number (or color) on the note cards and the page number where the fact, or note, was found.

 Due Friday, Dec. 3.
- 6) Outline and Works Cited page. Due Friday, Dec. 17.
- 7) Rough draft of paper. Due Friday, Jan. 21.
- 8) Final research paper, including works cited page, due Friday, March 4.
- 9) Oral presentations week of March 7.
