Path - disease  
Pulm - lung  
Sacr - sugar

### Suffixes

- ase (enzyme)  
- itis (inflammation)  
- lysis (break apart)  
- ology (study of)  
- ologist (studies)  
- ose (sugar)  
- oxide (containing oxygen)

### Examples

Embryology – study of organism development  
Hydrolysis – splitting apart of water molecule  
Sucrose – sugar  
Carditis – heart inflammation  
Microbiology – study of small (microscopic) organisms  
Bacteriology – a subset of microbiology in which  
bacteria are studied  
Biochemistry – study of chemical process that occur  
in living organisms
