- Union (Free States):** Indicated by a solid black outline. These states include Maine (ME), New Hampshire (NH), Vermont (VT), Massachusetts (MA), Connecticut (CT), Rhode Island (RI), New Jersey (NJ), Delaware (DE), Maryland (MD), Pennsylvania (PA), New York (NY), New Mexico (NM), Nevada (NV), California (CA), Oregon (OR), Washington (WA), Idaho (ID), Utah (UT), Arizona (AZ), and Colorado (CO).
- Border (Union Slave States):** Indicated by a dashed black outline. These states include Missouri (MO), Kentucky (KY), Tennessee (TN), and Arkansas (AR).
- Confederacy (Slave States):** Indicated by a solid black outline. These states include Virginia (VA), North Carolina (NC), South Carolina (SC), Georgia (GA), Florida (FL), Alabama (AL), Mississippi (MS), Louisiana (LA), Texas (TX), and the Confederate States of America (CSA).
