## The Fight for Freedom

Freedom—it's a gift we often take for granted, but not so for the early Americans who fought fiercely to gain independence from the British during the Revolutionary War.

Read the following passage about the American Revolution. Each blank stands for a missing number or date. From the list below the story, choose an answer that makes sense in each blank. Check off each one as you use it.

The American Revolution was fought between Britain and its \_\_\_\_\_ colonists in North America. Prior to the war, during the \_\_\_\_\_, life in the American colonies was very much like most advanced European nations. The main occupation of colonists was farming. The war began on April 19, \_\_\_\_\_, when American patriots and British soldiers clashed at Lexington, Massachusetts, and at nearby Concord. The Battle of Bunker Hill, which took place in June 1775, was the bloodiest battle of the entire war. The British went into the fight thinking the patriots would be easily defeated. Although the patriots retreated when they ran out of ammunition, the British suffered \_\_\_\_\_ casualties, while only \_\_\_\_\_ Americans were lost or wounded.

On July 4, \_\_\_\_\_, the \_\_\_\_\_ Continental Congress adopted the Declaration of Independence, declaring the colonies' freedom from British rule. The colonies had originally lacked a central government, an army, and a navy. The Continental Congress served as a national government and directed the war effort.

In \_\_\_\_\_, the American colonies won an important victory at Saratoga, New York. This victory convinced France, a longtime enemy of Britain, to help the Americans.

In October \_\_\_\_\_, a large British force surrendered at Yorktown, Virginia. This surrender led to peace talks, and \_\_\_\_\_ years later the war was finally over. The United Kingdom signed the Treaty of Paris on September 3, \_\_\_\_\_. The independence of the United States of America was finally a reality!
