


	Simple leaf with defined shape	2		Leaves in whorled pattern on stem	2
	Simple leaf with crenate shape	2		Furry leaf (the hair on the top to prevent evaporation)	2
	Simple leaf with circular shape	2		Variegated leaf (light and dark colors in some kind of pattern)	2
	Simple leaf with oval shape	2		Succulent leaf (very thick and juicy parts from dry climate)	1
	Simple palmate leaf	1		Leaf gall (this is a place where a leaf is "eaten" by an insect)	2
	Compound palmate leaf	1		Leaf containing a "leaf miner" (a larva that eats its way through a leaf)	5
	Simple pinnate leaf	1		Tendrils	2
	Doubly pinnate leaf + the leaflets are smaller	2		Stipules (these are the leaflets on the sides of the leaf)	2
