The *Association* feature: The information configuration is outlined hierarchically with headings and supportive attributes, is methodically connected to main concepts. The rating score is three (3); see Figure 1, quadrant S:CC.

The *Arrangement* feature: The evidence of this configuration contains a brief introduction and main idea units for the Body of the essay. The rating score is three (3); see Figure 1, quadrant T:CC.

The *Levels of Response* feature: This writer has four sub-headings: "Family, Personal spaces, Money, and Stress (parenthood)". These are the *Initial* responses with a rating score of one (1); see Figure 1, quadrant U:AA.

Under each sub-heading, the writer provided supportive information in point form, considered as *Intermediate* and total eight (8); the rating score is two (2); see Figure 1, quadrant V:BB.

The *Residual* response, "with food, clothing, electricity, etc.", is considered as an aggregate idea unit; they are considered as one *Residual* response; the rating score is one (1); see Figure 1, quadrant W:AA.

The *Elaboration* feature: The details written by the writer were classified under the relevant sub-headings; the writer has also constructed a brief summary of the concepts intended for the essay proper. The rating score is four (4); see Figure 1, quadrant X:DD.
