


Using **VALUE** in Drawing

When artists use value, they are using a variety of shades. This helps their artwork look more realistic, gives the composition more dimension, and appeals to the viewer's eye.



Above is an example of a value scale—it shows graduated value, from white, light gray, medium gray, and dark gray, to black. Using pressure to change the value tones, fill in the blank set of value scales to use as a reference for your artwork.
