In African countries, they don't use a knife or fork. They roll food into balls in the palms of their hands.

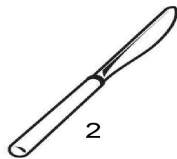
Lee, a little Chinese boy, doesn't like forks. With his two chopsticks he picks up rice, chicken and peas!

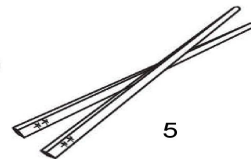
