Independent practice:

The <u>criminal</u> fled the scene of the crime. The genie granted <u>Aladdin</u> three wishes.

The criminal fled the <u>scene</u> of the crime. The genie granted Aladdin three <u>wishes</u>.

The criminal fled the scene of the <u>crime</u>. The genie granted three wishes to <u>Aladdin</u>.
