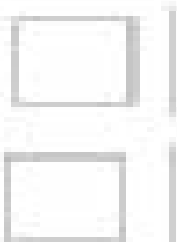

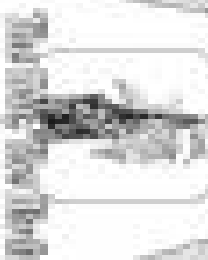
**CONFLICT:** *the struggle between two or more people, groups, or nations.*
