

The Past Tense Endings for REGULAR Verbs

In English: I played / I did play

Add the endings to the stem - ie. the infinitive minus the last two letters

	-AR	-ER / -IR
Yo	é	í
Tú	aste	iste
Él / Ella	ó	ió
Nosotros	amos	imos
Vosotros	asteis	isteis
Ellos / Ellas	aron	ieron

TOMAR = to take

To form "You took"

TOMAR > tom > tu tom**aste**
