
Plant Anatomy (Angiosperms)



The name angiosperm means "covered seed".

Angiosperms are flowering plants that produce seeds. The seeds are "covered" by a structure called fruit. When a seed falls to the ground, it sprouts and grows a new plant - the same kind of plant that the seed came from. There are more angiosperms today than any other kind of plant.
