I. The Steps

- Review "What is a Paragraph?" Make sure the students understand that a paragraph is about ONE MAIN IDEA.
- 2. Teach the Three-Paragraph Essay in 60 seconds. Start your watch! Ready..Set..Go!
- Prewriting Practice for the Three-Paragraph Essay. Creating your Three Main Ideas and listing your supporting details for each.
- 4. Introduction Paragraph Make a thesis statement and give your three main ideas.
- Conclusion Paragraph Summarize your thesis statement, review your three main ideas, and say goodbye.
- 6. Putting it All Together
- 7. Timed Prompt Writing
