Examples:

Their shows ownership.

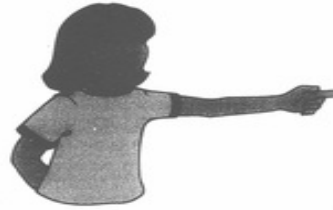
Examples:

Examples:
