Points to consider: Indents; topics, subtopics and details; You can't have a "I" without a "II" nor an "A" without a "B", nor a "1" without a "2", nor an "a" without a "b" (Two items are the minimum, most of these sub letters there should be more than 2). The more subletters you have, the easier it will be to do your paper.
