Disturbance - the disruption of the environment

Global warming - a gradual increase in world temperatures caused by pollution from such as carbon dioxide which we produce through the Earth's atmosphere from trapping heat from the sun

The Greenhouse effect - the process by which the atmosphere absorbs infrared radiation from the Earth's surface and re-emits it in all directions, including back to the Earth's surface

Pollution - is damage to the environment and health by harmful substances or waste, e.g. Toxic pollution, noise and air pollution, deforestation

Climate change - the change in the Earth's climate by affecting the world's weather and sea level rising

Endangered species - a biological species that is at risk of extinction because there are very few individuals
