## Service Learning and Enrichments 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies

One purpose of social studies is to help students develop the skills and knowledge necessary for them to be good citizens. Each semester every student is required to complete at least 12 hours of community service learning and/or enrichment opportunities. Examples include service projects, advanced readings, independent research, writing and other projects outside of the class room. Community service hours require a signed completion log and reflection. Enrichments will be made available throughout the school year and typically have a research, reading or viewing requirement and one page written reflection. Completed enrichments will be given a specified value (number of hours) and count toward the required 12 hours for this assignment. Students may receive "extra credit" consideration for completion of additional service learning and enrichment activities only if all other assignments have been satisfactorily completed and turned-in.

- You must complete a one page essay about your experience (see guidelines).
- You may substitute service hours with any completed enrichment activity for its provided value in service hours. This enrichment must also be documented on the "Service Hours Record" with its corresponding value in service hours and attached to this assignment page.
