

# JOINING SENTENCES CONJUNCTIONS

- and** ——— • It is used to add information.  
(Example: I'm tired **and** I'm going to bed.)
- but** ——— • It is used to contrast information.  
(Example: I'm tired **but** I have to finish this exercise.)
- because** — • It is used to give the reason for something.  
(Example: I'm tired **because** I couldn't sleep last night.)
- so** ——— • It is used to give the result of an action.  
(Example: I couldn't sleep last night **so** I'm tired.)
