

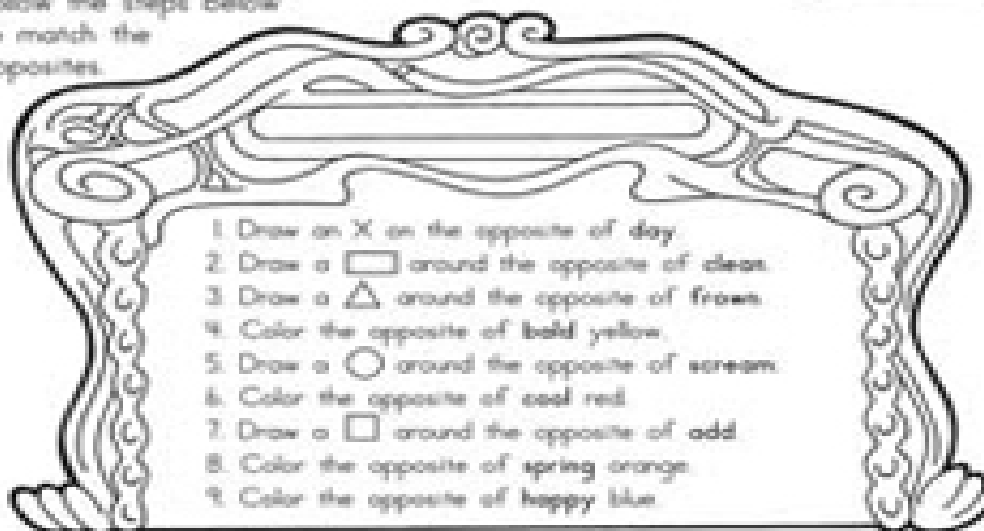

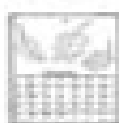
## Antonyms: Step-by-Step

Identifying opposites

Follow the steps below to match the opposites.



1. Draw an X on the opposite of day.
2. Draw a  around the opposite of clean.
3. Draw a  around the opposite of frozen.
4. Color the opposite of bald yellow.
5. Draw a  around the opposite of scream.
6. Color the opposite of cool red.
7. Draw a  around the opposite of add.
8. Color the opposite of spring orange.
9. Color the opposite of happy blue.
